- 220 volt AC shore supply with Victron Energy battery charger and 13 amp UK cabin sockets
- Pressurised hot & cold fresh water system (calorifier / immersion)
- Holding tank with manual overboard pump out
- Electric bilge pump
- Engine compartment light
- Windscreen wipers (2)
- Anaf automatic fire extinguisher in engine compartment

- Kemp silver anodised single spreader deck stepped mast, slab reefing boom and Selden rod kicker
- S/s standing rigging with Rotostay jib furling / reefing system

- Barlow 16 halyard winch on mast
- Sail wardrobe includes slab reefing mainsail and roller furling genoa

## **Accommodation**

- Single sea berth in companionway opposite
- Spacious pilothouse with raised dinette arrangement to starboard (converts to double berth)
- Reversible forward seat converts to double helm seat when under way
- Linear galley opposite with double s/s sinks, gimballed Flavel Vanessa 2 burner gas cooker / grill / oven and Engel fridge under seating opposite
- Forward deck hatch and large pilothouse roof hatches (2) provide adequate ventilation
- Blinds and curtains throughout cabin
- Good access to engine / battery compartment
- Steps up to well protected self-draining cockpit with teak sole and table
- Good stowage throughout yacht including hanging wardrobe, lockers under seats / berths and 3 large cockpit lockers
