2017 (model year 2018) Jeanneau Leader 30 with 260 hp Volvo Penta D4-260/DP diesel engine (under warranty until August 2024), which was commissioned for its Guernsey based owner in 2019, A popular model in the ever-growing Jeanneau range, designed by Mickael Peters Yacht Design, offering light and airy open plan accommodation for 4 persons and large social cockpit for al fresco dining. A beautifully presented, lightly used and reliable sports cruiser, making it an ideal choice for family trouble-free cruising in Channel Island waters and the adjacent French coast. Full service history (last serviced / antifouled July 2023).

ACCOMMODATION

- Spacious family accommodation for 4 in 2 cabins
- Open plan saloon with large dinette arrangement forward (converts to double berth) and privacy curtain
- Galley to port with Waeco fridge, Eno 2 burner gas hob (with hinged lid), Sharp microwave oven, dedicated cutlery locker and s/s sink
- Heads compartment opposite with new Jabsco electric flushing marine toilet (August 2023), wash hand basin / shower
- Separate aft cabin with changing area, seat and double berth
- Large hull windows, opening port lights, forward deck hatch and overhead rooflights above galley and aft cabin create light and airy atmosphere
- Cabin curtains / black out screens and metal venetian blind in galley
- Steps up to spacious open self-draining teak cockpit with rotating adjustable helm seat and folding foot stand to starboard
- Wet bar aft of helm seat with sink and Dometic fridge
- Very large seating area / chaise longue with teak folding table opposite (forward reversible passenger seat provides additional seating around table)
- Starboard companionway and s/s transom gate to very large teak bathing platform with folding s/s boarding ladder
- Ample stowage throughout boat including hanging wardrobes in both cabins, large cockpit lazarette and useful transom locker
