Description

2020 Parker 760 Quest, with efficient two-step hull and 225 hp Mercury V6 4-stroke outboard motor (60 hours), which was commissioned for its sole owners in April 2021. Impressive inventory includes bow thruster, electric anchor windlass, holding tank, shore power with battery charger, Raymarine multi-function colour display (radar / chartplotter / depthsounder), DSC VHF radio, inflatable tender with s/s storage rack, beaching legs and 6 hp auxiliary outboard motor. A great opportunity to acquire a reliable and lightly used example of these versatile pilothouse motor cruisers with weekend accommodation for 2 persons. Last serviced and antifouled in April 2023. Early inspection highly recommended.

- Galley aft of helm with sink and 12 volt Vitrifrigo fridge
- Raised dinette arrangement opposite with reversible passenger bench seat forward
- Sliding side windows and large sliding roof hatch provide excellent ventilation
- Sliding door to aft self-draining cockpit with “L” shaped seating and table to port
- Aft transom gate to starboard with good access to boarding platforms on either side
- Adequate stowage throughout boat including lockers under seats / berths and in cockpit lazarette
