

Description

1979 Warrior 35 Mk3, designed by Angus Primrose and built by Trident Marine, with 43 hp Beta 4cylinder diesel engine (2006) and regular service history. Since purchasing the yacht in 1997 and, in addition to installing the new diesel engine, the owner has spent a considerable sum on numerous other significant upgrades including new cabin windows (2010), Spars and mainsail (2011), feathering propeller (2013), liferaft (2023) and standing / running rigging (2024) to name but a few. A fully equipped and spacious long keel offshore cruiser with family accommodation for up to 6 persons, well protected centre cockpit and easy to handle rig.

• 43 hp Beta 4-cylinder diesel engine (2006) coupled to Darglow four bladed fully feathering propeller (2013) via s/s shaft gives 7+ knots maximum speed (6 knots cruising)

- Full engine instrumentation and single lever control
- Rope cutter
- Wheel steering with emergency tiller

• 12 volt DC electrical system (1 x engine and 2 x domestic batteries) with isolator switch charged by engine alternator

- 240 volt AC shore supply with cabin sockets
- Lofrans manual anchor windlass
- Pressurised hot and cold fresh water system (calorifier)
- Automatic electric bilge pump (2011)
- Eberspacher cabin heating
- Fireblitz automatic fire extinguisher in engine compartment

ACCOMMODATION

- Spacious family accommodation for 6 persons in 3 cabins including saloon
- Forward cabin with 2 'V' berths (infill cushion converts to double) and deck hatch
- Heads compartment to port with Lavac marine toilet, wash hand basin and new hot and cold shower (2009)
- Comfortable open plan saloon with galley to starboard equipped with gimballed Techimpex 2 burner gas cooker / grill / oven, s/s sink and fridge
- Navigation station / chart table aft of galley
- 'U' shaped dinette arrangement opposite (infill cushion on table converts to double berth) with deck hatch above
- Companionway steps up to self-draining centre cockpit with seats on either side, wheel pedestal and access hatch to engine compartment
- Good access to Treadmaster non-slip side decks
- Access hatch to separate aft cabin with 2 single berths (infill cushion converts to double)

• Good stowage throughout yacht including numerous cabin lockers, 2 hanging wardrobes, cockpit lockers and dedicated gas locker on aft deck
