## Description

2006 Nimbus 35 Nova with twin 260 hp Volvo Penta D4-260/DP EVC diesel engines and regular service history give 35 knots maximum speed. Since purchasing the boat in July 2022, the current owner has spared no expense on a thorough programme of maintenance, servicing and upgrades including new twin 12" Garmin multifunction colour displays (radar / chartplotter / sonar), Fantom 18 radar scanner, batteries, battery charger, propellers, marine electric toilet, tender and liferaft. Comprehensive cruising inventory also includes bow thruster, anchor windlass, cabin heating, holding tank, DSC VHF radio, AIS, autopilot and cockpit camper cover. An excellent example of these comfortable walk-around Scandinavian sports cruisers, renowned for their sturdy construction and sea keeping qualities. Early inspection recommended.

## **ACCOMMODATION**

- Comfortable accommodation for up to 5 persons in 3 cabins including pilothouse / deck saloon
- Forward cabin with 2 settee berths and table (infill cushion converts to double berth)
- Separate heads compartment to starboard with electric flushing marine toilet (striped down and, with the exception of the bowl, all parts were relaced in 2023), wash hand basin / shower with curtain and mirror
- Guest cabin opposite with large double berth
- Overhead deck hatch and opening port holes provide adequate ventilation
- Companionway steps, with door / hatch providing privacy for forward cabins, up to spacious pilothouse / deck saloon
- Teak / holly flooring in forward cabins and teak decking in pilothouse / deck saloon
- Helm console with adjustable rotating seat to starboard
- Galley aft of helm with Corian worktop, Eno 2 burner gas cooker, s/s sink, Isotherm fridge and Nimbus crockery / cutlery
- Raised 'L' shaped seating with table and chaise longue (occasional single berth) opposite
- Electrically opening sunroof and opening side windows create light and airy atmosphere
- Curtains and black-out screens in all cabins
- Glazed sliding door to very large self-draining teak cockpit with easy access to walk-around teak side decks
- Excellent access to cockpit lazarette and spacious engine compartment
- Aft s/s folding seats and removable transom gates (3) to large teak boarding platform with s/s folding swim ladder
- Excellent stowage throughout boat including hanging wardrobes, numerous lockers / drawers, cockpit lazarette and engine compartment
