## Description

Southerly 28, designed by John Bennett and built by Northshore Yachts Ltd in 1975 (1 of 148), with 30 hp 2-Yanmar 3GM30 3-cylinder diesel engine (2007) and regular service history (last serviced in May 2024). Comprehensive specification / inventory includes auxiliary outboard motor, beaching legs, furling jib, chartplotter, autopilot, wind speed / direction, DSC VHF radio, cockpit table, tender and liferaft. A well maintained and presented example of these flexible cruising yachts, renowned for their light and airy pilothouse / saloon with internal helm station, pivoting lifting keel / centreboard and ability to safely navigate in shallow waters. A particularly attractive choice for the first time buyer and for those wishing to explore coastal waters, estuaries and inland waterways. Inspection recommended.

- 5 hp Mercury 2-stroke auxiliary outboard motor mounted on lifting transom bracket (2012)
- 12 volt DC electrical system (2 batteries) with isolator switch charged by engine alternator and portable solar panel
- Winch (with cover) mounted on top of housing for centreboard / lifting keel
- Electric bilge pump

- Open plan pilothouse / saloon with large 'U' shaped seating around adjustable height table to port (infill converts to double berth)
- Galley opposite with Flaval B700 2 burner gas cooker / grill / oven and s/s sink with Whale manual fresh water pump
- Inside steering position with folding seat and large quarter berth aft of galley
- Separate heads compartment opposite with Lavac marine toilet (2012) and wash hand basin with Whale manual fresh water pump
- Steps over engine compartment up to well protected self-draining cockpit with good access to painted non-slip side decks
- Good stowage throughout yacht including numerous lockers under seats / berths, hanging wardrobe, large cockpit lazarette and separate gas locker
