Description

1992 Rinker 300 Fiesta Vee with twin 225 hp Volvo Penta 4.3 GXi/DP petrol engines (2011), low hours and full service history (engines and stern drives last serviced in September 2024). Since purchasing the boat in early 2022, the current owners have spared no expense on a thorough programme of maintenance, annual servicing and upgrades, including new chartplotter / depthsounder, AIS transceiver, DSC VHF radio, batteries, televisions, cabin heaters, heads compartment shower, galley cooker and worktop, cockpit / cabin upholstery, foredeck sun bathing cushion and hull stripes, to name but a few. A reliable and exceptionally well presented sports cruiser, with spacious open plan family accommodation for up to 6 persons, which must be seen to be fully appreciated. British Part 1 Registered.
