# Description

1997 Victoria 38, designed by Chuck Paine and built by Victoria Yachts in the UK, with 38 hp Yanmar 3JH2E diesel engine and full service history (last serviced in April 2024). A truly excellent example of these renowned heavy displacement blue water cruising yachts with classic lines, long fin keel and skeg hung rudder. No expense has been spared by the current owners on numerous substantial upgrades including new feathering propeller, Garmin electronics package, AIS, windvane, solar panel, battery charger, deck hatches / portlights, holding tank, upholstery and much more. Hull epoxy coated from new. Must be seen to be fully appreciated.

- Light and airy forward cabin with 2 'V' berths (infill cushion converts to double berth)
- Large heads compartment to port with Jabsco marine toilet (new pipework in 2023), wash hand basin, mirror and separate shower with electric pump out
- Spacious open plan saloon with full width dinette arrangement forward
- Central folding table with 'U' shaped settee / sea berth with lee cloth to port (infill cushion converts to double berth)
- Settee / sea berth with lee cloth opposite
- Galley to rear of saloon on port side with acrylic worktops, large Isotherm chest fridge, gimballed Smev 4 burner gas cooker / grill / oven and s/s sinks (2)
- Forward facing chart table with seat opposite
- Aft cabin with large single berth and cockpit window
- New Lewmar opening deck hatches / portlights (2023) and dorade vents provide adequate ventilation
- Good access to sound insulated engine compartment under companionway steps up to large well protected teak self-draining cockpit with high coamings, teak grating, wheel pedestal and good access to decks
